Abstract. We provide an alphabetical listing of those observatories that are known to publish annual reports. The entries include descriptions of both print and electronic versions, including hyper links to the reports if available. The list is located on the web at http://www.eso.org/libraries/reports.html.

1. Purpose

This web site provides an alphabetical listing of those observatories that are known to publish annual reports. It is based on reports on paper received in the ESO and CFHT libraries and was complemented by entries of electronic-only reports which we found while perusing the web.

The descriptions include information about the title, format (paper and/or electronic) and availability ("published since") of reports as well the names and e-mail addresses of contact persons. If available, hyper links to the electronic versions of reports are provided.




Figure 1. Annual Reports of Observatories on the Web.

As of April 2002, the listing contains 91 entries; it is located on the web at http://www.eso.org/libraries/reports.html (Fig. 1).

2. How to use it:

Use the side bar to scroll through the entire list or use the search option to find any name of an observatory. You will receive one or several results. Hyperlinks lead to home pages of observatories, e-mail addresses of contact persons and electronic versions of annual reports.
