in touch with instruments and operations in a way that would not be possible in many other institutes. I am extremely grateful also for all the personal support from the ESO staff in the last 1.5 years, which have not always been easy. On the other hand, the scientific environment in Santiago is rich and exciting, and allows me to touch ground and start new collaborations with teams at several universi-

ties. In my free time, I enjoy learning more about Chilean culture, visiting museums and theatres in Santiago, and Chile itself, exploring deserts and mountains and, of course, the beach.


