2. In 2016, seven planets were found orbiting a very cool dwarf star — TRAPPIST-1.		
3. Now, astronomers have found that some of these planets probably hold about 250 times more water than all of Earth's oceans!		
4. The 4th of the seven planets, called TRAPPIST-1e, is the most similar to Earth, in terms of size, density, and radiation received from its star.
