1. The SPHERE instrument on ESO's VLT has revealed <b>dusty discs that surround nearby young stars</b> in greater detail than ever before.		
2. The discs around these stars contain the building blocks of planets		
3 and the new images from SPHERE show what our own Solar System may have looked like in the early stages of its formation.		
4. The discs display a bizarre variety of shapes, sizes and structures		
5 some contain bright rings, some dark ring-shaped gaps and some even resemble hamburgers!		
6. This new SPHERE data is helping astronomers to understand the complex mechanisms of planet formation.
